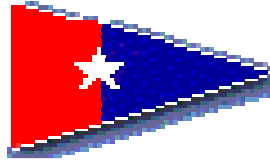

NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of U.S. Sailing Association, and the Rules of the American Y-Flyer Yacht Racing Association.

ENTRY

Skippers and crews who are members of the American or Canadian Y-Flyer Yacht Racing Associations may be entered by completing registration with the regatta organizing authority. AYFYRA membership forms will be available at registration. The entry fee is \$105.00 US with a \$5.00 discount for members of U.S. Sailing or Canadian Yacht Association. After Feb.13, 2010 the late entry fee is \$120.00 US with no discount. Entry fee includes all meals for skippers and crews.

Directions to Columbia Sailing Club

Generally, by driving on various roads, you can get here from anywhere. The trick is to use the *right* roads. To get to the general vicinity of the eastern end of the lake, follow the directions below:

From I-77

If you're coming south on I-77, hang a right onto I-20 west towards Columbia, then a right onto I-26 west towards Spartanburg.

From I-26 west-bound

If you're coming from I-95 or Charleston, you'll pass to the west of the city of Columbia, then over the I-20 interchange at what we locals lovingly call *malfunction junction*. If you're getting on I-26 from I-20 (either direction) go west towards Spartanburg until you find the Highway 60 exit for Irmo (exit 102A). Go west (that's a left) on 60 for 3.9 miles. When you get to stoplight at the dam, take a right onto Highway 6 (yes, west *again*). Go a short distance (about 0.5 miles) before turning left onto the first paved road on your left, which will be Shuler Road. That road makes a sharp left, another sharp left, and a hairpin right before terminating at the gate to CSC.

From I-26 east-bound

Take exit for Highway 60 (exit 102A). Go west on 60 for 3.9 miles. When you get to stoplight at the dam, take a right onto Highway 6 (yes, west *again*). Go a short distance (about 0.5 miles) before turning left onto the first paved road on your left, which will be Shuler Road. That road makes a sharp left, another sharp left, and a hairpin right before terminating at the gate to CSC.

Camping

Bring your tent and sleeping bag, or better yet, your motorhome, and camp at the Club. We can accommodate about 5-10 camping groups, depending on how much stuff they bring. Electricity is available on a panel in the middle of the camping area, not at each site, and the bathhouse is close by so you can stumble in to the shower in the AM without walking too far. There is also a new bathhouse on the north side of the back cove. Of course all sites have a great water view. Picnic shelters, grills and so forth are right there, but we hope you will join us for meals provided with your registration.
